What is a Classroom Tutor (CT)?

CTs are assigned to a specific class that they regularly attend. During each class session, the CT identifies difficult concepts and topics and then leads a CT session (tutoring session) immediately after class. These sessions utilize peer interaction and guided study so that students collaborate with one another to better understand the material and succeed in the course.
