What is a Classroom Tutor (CT)?

CTs are assigned to a specific class that they attend. During each class session, the CT identifies concepts and topics that students are having difficulty with and then leads a CT session (tutoring session) immediately after class. These sessions utilize peer interaction and guided study so that students collaborate with one another to better understand the material and succeed in the course.

DETAILS AND QUALIFICATIONS —

- ❖ Make \$11.71 an hour
- ❖ Work 6-10 hours a week for the semester
- Duties
 - Attend assigned class and lead tutoring sessions afterward
 - Develop weekly tutoring lesson plan and submit required weekly reports
 - Attend professional development opportunities as well as all mandatory training
- Must have:
 - o A grade of A or B in the class you will tutor for
 - o Minimum 2.5 GPA overall
 - At least 12 units during the semester you tutor
