INVESTIGATING RANDOMNESS: Real or Fake? (3 points extra credit!)

You will pick a card in class. Do **not** show your card to anyone else. Do **not** mark your group:

If you get a black card (club or spade):

Flip a small coin (a penny or a dime) 100 times. After each flip, write an "H" when you get a head, and write a "T" when you get a tail. You could also use this website to flip coins for you: https://www.random.org/coins/

If you get a red card (heart or diamond):

Flip a coin 100 times "in your head." After each flip, write an "H" when you get a head, and write a "T" when you get a tail. In other words, write a sequence of "H"s and "T"s that you think "looks random," assuming that you're flipping a fair coin (equally likely to come up heads as tails).
