

MATH 119 - RULES FOR THE TEST (QUIZ #1) – WED., 2/23

• NOTE: The **old exams** on my website (near the bottom) will be very helpful, but your exams will have both similarities and differences. The old solutions only really help you if you look at them **after** you try the old test!

§ Room MS-418 is on the fourth floor of the huge MS-100 building (near the Marlesta/Chasewood entrance to the Mesa campus). In MS-100:

- From the main elevators, make three rights (or a left to the back door).
- From the main stairs, make two rights (to the back or front doors).
- You may enter using either door.

§ For the test, bring:

- **Mask**
- Homework (HW)
- Scientific calculator
- Pencil / pen (maybe not blue - I may grade in blue!) / eraser
- Water bottle + snacks (suggested) – many things will be turned “off” in MS

§ Turn in the HW

- Staple your packet(s) with your name.
- No binders; it may be a while until you get them back.
- You can turn in the HW soon **after** the test, but **don't forget** about it!

§ A **formula sheet** will be provided, similar to the one on my website.

§ I'll hand out scratch paper.

- The back of a test may be used as scratch; it depends on the # of pages.
- Turn in **all** scratch paper with your test.
- Staple what you want graded.
- Neater work is more likely to be graded.
- On the main test, write “SEE SCRATCH” (or the like) on a problem you are continuing on scratch paper.

§ If you take a bathroom break (try to avoid during the test):

- Give me your cell phone.
- I expect to photograph your test.

§ When you're done with the test, give the **test and scratch paper** to me.
(**Also the HW** if you haven't submitted it!)

- Return to your desk or exit quietly. You may work on your HW.
- Do not discuss the test. People may come in late.
- We may discuss solutions after the test.

§ I expect to allot 1 hour and 20 minutes for each exam (including the Final, even though it is worth 20% more than a quiz).

§ **Office hours** will be on campus on the test day, Wednesday, 4:30-5:45pm, in MS-215P on the second floor. It's three rights from the elevator. Beyond the glass doors, go either left and then right or right and then left.
