### ATTENTION SDSU TRANSFERS:

If you are a Business, Communication or Psychology major who plans to attend SDSU this is important. There is no longer a TAG contract for these majors. To have priority admission, you must complete an Associate's Degree for Transfer (ADT). Stop by Counseling Office or the Transfer Center for more details.

### Did you know?

You need to complete all of the steps below to receive priority admissions from an ADT (Associate Degree for Transfer):

1. Meet with a counselor to create an education plan for your ADT major.
2. Apply for graduation through Reg-E at least two semesters before you plan on transferring.
3. Indicate your ADT major on your CSU Mentor application.
4. Follow the verification procedure to the CSU's that you have applied to. The online verification process should be available for this year.

### Applications:

The **UC TAG** and **UCSD University Link** contracts are separately from the **UC application**.

- **UC TAG** online contracts are due September 30.
- **UCSD University Link** online contracts are due during your first year of community college. (\*Veterans and Foster Youth can apply at any time.)
- **UC Admissions** application are available starting August 1st and can be submitted between November 1—30th.

The **SDSU TAG** is applied for through the regular CSU Mentor application.

- **CSU Admissions** application period is October 1—November 30th.

### Transfer Myth:

*The TAG program is going away!*

### **Not True!**

*The TAG program is still available for many UC schools and SDSU. There are still six University of California schools that continue to offer TAG contracts. UCSD offers the University Link Program for first year students, veterans and foster youth. SDSU still has many majors that offer TAG.*
