This month's main story:

Don't miss important Transfer Deadlines. Each college/university that you have applied to has different deadlines for documentation including transcripts, verification of Associate Degrees for Transfer (ADT) for CSUs, and other paperwork. It is the student's responsibility to be aware of these deadlines and to meet them. Missing a deadline could be cause for denial of admissions.

Remember that prospective schools communicate with you using the email you supplied on your application. If you have not received communication from the colleges/universities that you have applied to, check your "junk or spam" folder. The Transfer Center has seen students who have missed emails or used more than one e-mail, and it has created transfer problems for these students.

Transfer Myth: *I should only apply to schools I'm sure I'll be accepted to: Not True!: You should also apply to schools that are a 'reach'. Remember, nothing ventured.....and Mesa students have been accepted as transfer students to MIT, Stanford, Caltech and Harvard, why not you? We have some great success stories, so give it a try!*



The University Link Transfer Program for UCSD is changing!

If you are in your first year of community college, or a veteran; you are still eligible to sign the ULink contract. The 2013-2014 U Link contract guarantees admission to UCSD with 60 transferable units and a 3.0 GPA. The 2014-2015 contract will increase to a 3.5 GPA, and have an income limit of \$40,000.

Did you know?

If you are denied admission to a university, you have the option of appealing.
