## Main Story:

There are recent changes in the majors offered at SDSU. Make sure that you apply for the right major! Stop by the Transfer Center or the Counseling Office for more information.....

CSU San Marcos has become more accessible to Mesa College students. If you are completing an ADT, you will now have priority admissions, except in the impacted majors of Business, Kinesiology and Nursing. If you're not completing an ADT, then this is the last time that you'll be able to attain local student status by completing one (1) transferable class at a N. County Community College.

**Transfer Myth:** I should not appeal if I don't get into the school I really want.

**Truth:** You should always appeal! There is a chance that your appeal will be honored. If you don't appeal, you will have possibly missed an opportunity..

**Did you know?** That you should apply to multiple schools to give yourself the best chance of being accepted.

## Things to Look For:

- Get your application reviewed in the Transfer Center before you send it, and don't forget to make a copy!
- Make a counseling appointment. The rules covering transfer requirements are complicated.

Make sure that you apply on time and follow up with all requirements. Take a look at the transfer center website in the "Transfer Planning" section. It includes dates and deadlines you need to know for a successful transfer.

Don't forget to print or make a digital copy of every application that you submit!

## Application Assistance

Make your transfer plan a successful one. Apply to at least FIVE schools. If you qualify, there are fee waivers for up to four CSU and four UC Applications. A fee waiver is also available for all private schools in California, and many out of state ones. The basic criteria is Pell-Grant eligibility. Remember to stop by the Transfer Center to get any application help that you might need.
